St. Vincent Family Centers to Offer Parenting Classes

Columbus - St. Vincent Family Centers is offering parenting classes through its Hispanic Latino Program. Class sessions will be held January 30 through March 19, at the agency's Franklinton Office, 840 West State Street. The classes, which will be conducted in Spanish, are free but registration is required.

St. Vincent Family Centers serves children who have severe emotional and behavioral problems. The agency provides unique mental health services and programs, ranging from outpatient and Deaf services to preschool and school age partial hospitalization programs.

The *Incredible Years* are evidence based programs for reducing children's aggression and behavior problems and increasing social competence at home and at school. In addition to parenting classes, St. Vincent Family Centers Early Childhood Mental Health consultants work with daycare centers throughout Franklin County.

The Hispanic Latino Program parenting classes are open to parents of children two – 10 years of age. Classes will be conducted in Spanish. For registration information call 614-221-7855.
