



## 2019 Foster Care Pre-Service Training Calendar

- A. Registration: Please contact St. Vincent Family Center 614-252-0731 and ask to speak to either Vicki Baden or Sarah Lawson to register for the classes.
- B. Class Reminders: Please arrive 15 minutes early, as class will begin promptly at 6:00PM for evening trainings, 9:00AM for Saturday morning trainings. Note: If you miss more than 15 minutes of class you will not get credit for the class and will have to retake the class at a later date. Children are not permitted to attend pre-service trainings due to the content of the information being discussed. We will provide a light snack for trainings during the week and lunch on Saturday's. Feel free to bring your own food/drinks as well.
- C. Cancellations: Please notify Vicki Baden or Sarah Lawson if you need to miss class, if running late, or to register for the next time the class is offered.
- D. Parking: Weekday classes please park on Kelton Avenue and sign in at the front desk. Saturday classes only you will need to park in the back parking lot (Parking lot entrance is off of Miller Avenue, take E. Rich Street to the parking lot in the back of the building).
- E. Foster Parent Licensure: Each foster parent will need to complete each of the classes in their entirety (in any order) and complete/ successfully pass all required background checks, documentation, homestudy assessment visits, and other state requirements in order to become licensed foster parents. These requirements will be discussed in more detail during pre-service training.
